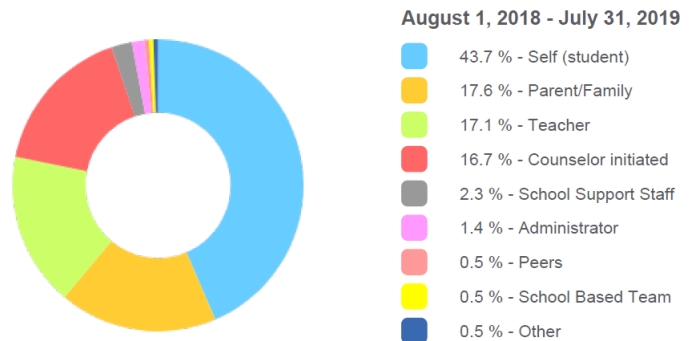

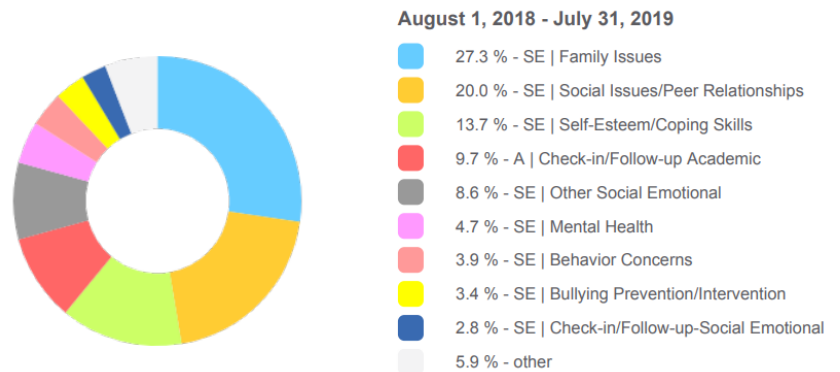
Individual Counseling
